BIG IDEA: We will live in a vital relationship with the Holy Spirit and the Word of God.

READ: John 3:3-7, 1 Peter 1:23-25

THINK: As you reflect on the teaching from God's Word today, ask yourself these questions: What would others learn about your parents simply by observing your life for a day? A week? A month? A year? How would you explain the relationship between the Holy Spirit and the Word of God (the Bible)? Why is the Holy Spirit necessary for "the new birth"?
