Application Study Guide "CHARTING OUR COURSE: The Right Provisions" Acts 4:32-37 Sunday, February 7, 2021

READ: Acts 4:32-37; 5:1-11; 2:42-47

THINK: Think about the generosity of the early church and Barnabas in particular then ask yourself these questions: When have you experienced unity like what is described in today's text? Compare v32-35 with Acts 2:42-47. What qualities mark this church? What is the relationship between the Ministry of the Word and material generosity? Why does Dr. Luke include the brief bio on Barnabas and his generous example? How does the sad scenario of Ananias and Sapphira strike you after reading the previous paragraphs at the end of chapter 4? Were Ananias & Sapphira required to sell their land and give the proceeds to the Church? Why did this couple lie to the Church? How are they found lying to the Holy Spirit? Why the harsh judgement here?

DO: How well does today's Scripture passage describe your relationship with the Church? What would have to change in your life for such generous sharing to be possible? If necessary, consider looking into either Dave Ramsey's "Financial Peace University" or Rob West's financial planning resources at MoneyWise.org.
