Sunday, February 21, 2021

READ: Acts 1:1-8

THINK: Consider the implications of the Gospel as revealed in Acts 1:8, then ask yourself these questions: Who is speaking to the disciples in this verse? What gives His words weight? How does the Word give power to the Gospel? How does the Spirit give power to the Gospel? How does Jesus Christ give power to the Gospel? In what sense is the power of Gospel in Christians? How did your understanding of “witness” change after studying this passage? What is your “Jerusalem”? Your Judea/Samaria? What do you imagine to be the “ends of the earth”?

DO: On a scale of 1-10 rate your passion for sharing the Gospel, 1 being the least and 10 being the greatest. Consider how you can be involved in sharing the Gospel at home and abroad. Ask God to show you in what capacity and to what extent He wants you to be a witness.
