BIG IDEA: God wants Whitneyville Bible Church to be unified.

READ: Ephesians 4:1-6; 1 Corinthians 12:4-14

THINK: Reflect on the 4 key components for unity and then ask yourself these questions: Why is unity so important for a church? What are the ramifications when a church loses its unity and becomes divided? Why is it important to live a life worthy of our calling? Which of the 4 key components do you see displayed in your life? Which of the 4 key components is the hardest for you? Why is so easy to major on minor issues instead of majoring on the 7 unifying truths?

DO: Prayerfully ask the Lord to help you live a life of humility, patience, gentleness and love. Identify a way that you can demonstrate humility, patience, gentleness or love to the church body this week and then do it.
