What, if anything, could buy wisdom? On the other hand, what could wisdom buy? If “Christ” could be substituted for “Wisdom” in Proverbs chapter 8, how would that affect your view or application of its main points?

DO: How is your personal search for WISDOM going?

BIG IDEA: Common sense is not as common as it should be.

*“Learn to be shrewd, you who are inexperienced;
develop common sense, you who are foolish.”
Proverbs 8:5 (CSB)*

BIG IDEA: Common sense is not as common as it should be.

READ: Proverbs 8:1-11, 32-36

THINK: As you listen for the voice of WISDOM, ask yourself these questions: *“Listen, I have something worth saying” - how many times have you heard that line before? From whom? Was it worthy? How do we discern the worthiness of ideas? Wisdom is begging us to listen; are you listening? Why or why not? Would wisdom make it on your bucket list of achievements or your Top 10 Most Precious Things in the World?*
