BIG IDEA: A good church makes a pastor's heart glad.

READ: 1 Thessalonians 1:1-10

THINK: Think about something, then ask yourself these questions: What teams did you belong to (or aspire to) as a child? What are some of the details you recall about Paul's experience in founding the Thessalonian Church (see Acts 17:1-10)? What convinced Paul the Thessalonians were indeed chosen by God? How did they first become imitators of, and then models for, the faith (v6-10)? What does this tell you

about their growth in Christ? In an age without mass media, how do you suppose their faith became so "legendary"?

DO: What kind of model are you in matters of faith: Still on the drawing board? A work in progress? Secured in a private collection? On display at the National Museum? Which of the Christian virtues in v3 do you most wish to see developed in your life now?
