BIG IDEA: God reveals mysteries in ways we may not expect.

"...there is a God in Heaven who reveals mysteries..."

Daniel 2:28a (CSB)

- Nebuchadnezzar <u>DISTRESSES</u> over his <u>DREAM</u>. (v 1)
- Nebuchadnezzar <u>TESTS</u> his <u>ADVISORS</u>. (v 2-13)
- Daniel <u>SEEKS</u> God's <u>WISDOM</u>. (v 14-19a)
- Daniel <u>PRAISES</u> and <u>THANKS</u> God. (v 19b-23)
- Daniel <u>REQUESTS</u> an <u>AUDIENCE</u> with the <u>KING</u>. (v 24-30)
- Daniel <u>RECOUNTS</u> & <u>INTERPRETS</u> Nebuchadnezzar's <u>DREAM</u>. (v 31-45)

ELESSONS (So, what am I going to do about it?):

- o Remember, GOD is in CONTROL.
- Human <u>EFFORTS</u> and <u>ENTERPRISES</u> are in <u>PROGRESSIVE</u>
 DECLINE.
- o Always be <u>FAITHFUL</u> in <u>PROCLAIMING</u> the <u>TRUTH</u>.
- Don't miss this: <u>JESUS</u> will <u>RETURN</u> to <u>RULE</u> and <u>REIGN</u> FOREVER!

Nebuchadnezzar HONORS Daniel. (v 46-49)

BIG IDEA: God reveals mysteries in ways we may not expect.

Read: Daniel 2:1-49

Think: Reflect on this dramatic story and then ask yourself the following questions: What was the cause of Nebuchadnezzar's deep distress after his recurring dream? Why could the King's advisors offer no explanation about the King's dream? What was the cause of the King's rage at his advisors? What distinguishes Daniel (& his three friends) from the rest of the advisors? What is the focus of Daniel's prayer (v 19-23)? What stands out to you about Daniel's audience with the King? How do you think Daniel felt in describing Nebuchadnezzar's dream and it's meaning to the King? What do you imagine was going through Nebuchadnezzar's mind as he heard Daniel describe and explain his dream? What lesson(s) can you take away from the interpretation of Nebuchadnezzar's dream? Is Nebuchadnezzar's reaction to Daniel over the top or spot on?

Do: Stop and think about what message God has been trying to get through to you repeatedly. Write out a list of "answers" you can pray, praise, and thank God about. What comfort or distress do you receive as you consider the future as revealed through Nebuchadnezzar's dream? Think about your response to God as the "revealer of mysteries".
