**BIG IDEA**: Christ-followers are Guardians of God's resources.

Think: Contemplate the significance of Jesus' expectation for TIME, TALENT, TREASURE, TIES, & TEMPLE
for His disciples and then ask these questions: What is my attitude toward time management? How does
eternity inform my use of time? What is my attitude toward my talents and abilities? What eternal values
direct the development and use of my talent? What is my attitude toward my material resources? What
eternal investments am I making with my material possessions? What is my attitude toward my varied
relationships? How do I manage those relationships as a follower of Jesus Christ? What is my attitude
toward my body and its various parts in response to the Lordship of Christ?

**DO:** When did you come to realize that following Jesus is costly? How so? Ever wondered since then if the cost was worth it? What keeps you going as a DISCIPLE of the Lord Jesus Christ?
