“I will grant my two witnesses authority to prophesy...”

Revelation 11:3a (CSB)



The location of the two witnesses.

- The city of Jerusalem.
- The Temple in Jerusalem.



The time of the two witnesses.

- 42 months.
- 1260 days.
- 3½ years.



The identity of the two witnesses.

- Moses & Elijah?
- Enoch & Elijah?
- Two other non-biblical personalities?



The ministry of the two witnesses.

- A Ministry of Prophecy.

- A Ministry of Miracles.

Observations.

- The Bible warns that the Nation of Israel will be persistently oppressed by the Gentile nations.
- God has not relinquished His authority.
- God graciously provides a witness even in the harshest of times and to the most belligerent of people.

BIG IDEA: God is never without a witness to the truth of His Word.

READ: Revelation 11:1-6

THINK: As you consider the ministry of these two witnesses, ask yourself the following questions: *What is John commanded to do? Why? Why are Jerusalem and the Temple identified? Why is the Temple measured and why are the worshipers counted? How is the relationship between “the holy city” and the Nations characterized? What is the significance of the time markers in Chapter 11 (42 months, 1260 days)? Who are the two witnesses? Why are there two witnesses? What is their message? Why are they granted miraculous power?*

DO: Where is God calling you to be a witness today?
