"FAITH Alone"

BIG IDEA: How can we be saved? By grace alone, through FAITH alone.

"The righteousness of God is through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe, since there is no distinction" Romans 3:22 (CSB)

- Righteousness is God's standard of perfection.
- Righteousness is acquired through FAITH alone.
- Righteousness is accomplished by the person and work of Jesus Christ.
- Righteousness is available to everyone.

BIG IDEA: How can we be saved? By grace alone, through FAITH alone.

READ: Romans 3:21-31 & Hebrews 11:1, 6

THINK: Think about biblical FAITH, then ask yourself these questions: When have you had to trust someone else for a positive outcome in a particular situation? How would you explain "the righteousness of God"? What does the Bible mean by FAITH?

Why does Paul explain that right standing before God is only achieved by FAITH? Why must our FAITH be in Jesus Christ in order to receive righteous standing before God? How does ready access to God's righteousness "to all who believe" magnify its worth to humanity? Explain the proper relationship between FAITH and WORKS.

DO: Ask yourself what you're trusting for salvation and your eternal destiny. How does your FAITH need to be put into action this week?
