**BIG IDEA:** An inevitable storm of judgment is coming.

*“Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels,  
“Go and pour out the seven bowls of God’s wrath on the earth.”  
Revelation 16:1 (CSB)*

### **The Consummation of God’s Final Judgment: The Bowl Judgments (16:1-21)**

- **BOWL #1: World-wide vegetation devastated. (v1-2)**
- **BOWL #2: World-wide oceanic devastation. (v3)**
- **BOWL #3: World-wide fresh water contamination. (v4-7)**
- **BOWL #4: World-wide celestial darkness. (v8-9)**

### **Observations.**

- **Nothing happens by accident.**
- **God’s judgment is terrible, yet just.**
- **Keep your heart sensitive to the things of God.**
- **Repent, seek forgiveness, and give God glory.**

**BIG IDEA:** An inevitable storm of judgment is coming.

**READ:** Revelation 16:1-9

**THINK:** Consider the seriousness and severity of God’s final judgment during the Great Tribulation, and then ask yourself the following questions: *What contents are in each of the first four BOWL JUDGMENTS? Why are these plagues worse than those ushered in by the SEAL & TRUMPET JUDGMENTS? Why does the angel (16:5) respond to the outpouring of God’s wrath with recognition of divine justice rather than with a sense of pain or sorrow? What is your response to that angel’s in v5-6? What do you make of the words John heard from the altar in v7? Why do you suppose the people of the earth are unrepentant and blaspheme God?*

**DO:** How receptive are you to admitting your guilt and repenting when you sin? How would you explain the just and righteous necessity of these plagues to someone who is not a Christian?
