Revelation 14:1-5, 12-13

THINK: Think about the harvest described in this passage, then ask yourself the following questions: *Who are the 144,000? How are they identified here? What is the significance of them being redeemed from the earth and the human race (v3-4)? What do they sow and what do they reap? Why are they described as “first fruits”?*
DO: Describe the crop that is destined to result from what you are sowing today. Identify what needs to change in order to achieve a Harvest of Righteousness.

BIG IDEA: We each reap what we sow.

*“Don’t be deceived:
God is not mocked.
For whatever a person sows he will also reap,”
Galatians 6:7 (CSB)*

A Harvest of Righteousness. (14:1-5, 12-13)

- Harvested to stand. (v1)
- Harvested to sing. (v2-3)
- Harvested for separation. (v4-5)
- Harvested for salvation. (v12-13)

Observations.

- Decide now, to follow Jesus.
- Avoid deceitfulness.
- Anticipate the blessing of the Lord.
- Consider what “crops” need to be rotated or cultivated in order to achieve a HARVEST of RIGHTEOUSNESS.

BIG IDEA: We each reap what we sow.
