**BIG IDEA:** We each reap what we sow.

*“Don’t be deceived:  
God is not mocked.  
For whatever a person sows he will also reap,”  
Galatians 6:7 (CSB)*



### **A Harvest of Unrighteousness.** (14:6-20)

- **Message of the Harvest #1: “Judgment has come.”** (v6-7)
- **Message of the Harvest #2: “Babylon has fallen.”** (v8)
- **Message of the Harvest #3: “Escape God’s wrath.”** (v9-13)
- **Message of the Harvest #4: “Harvest the grain.”** (v14-16)
- **Message of the Harvest #5: “Harvest the vine.”** (v17-20)



### **Laws of the Harvest.**

- **Law #1: I always reap what I sow.**
  - Sow a thought; reap an act.
  - Sow an act; reap an habit.
  - Sow a habit; reap an character.
  - Sow a character; reap an destiny.

- **Law #2: I always reap more than I sow.**
- **Law #3: I always reap later than I sow.**

**BIG IDEA:** We each reap what we sow.

**READ:** Revelation 14:6-20

**THINK:** Think about the harvest described in this passage, then ask yourself the following questions: *What is meant by “the eternal gospel” here in v6 and what is the response to its proclamation? What is the significance of each of the angelic messengers and their warnings: v6-7, v8, v9-13, v16-17, v17-20? Why the distinction between the harvest of the grain and the vine (v14-20)? What contrasts do you find here between those who worship the Creator and those who worship the beast?*

**DO:** Reflect on the “Laws of the Harvest” shared in today’s message. Make four separate lists of what you are sowing in your life: thoughts, acts, habits, character. Describe the crop destined to result from what you are sowing today.
