Matthew 21:1-11

Kingdom? How might the description of Jesus' Kingdom account for many from the same crowd jeering and shouting later, "Crucify Him!"?

DO: What difference does it make to you that Jesus is King? How would you have reacted if you had been there to greet Jesus riding into town? Does Jesus' humility work for you or would you prefer or more aggressive leader? What do you need to do in order to bow the knee to Jesus as King, Lord and Savior? What decision does Jesus want you to make today as you recognize Him as King?

BIG IDEA: The King of kings has come!

*“Hosanna to the Son of David!
Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!
Hosanna in the highest heaven!”
Matthew 21:9 (CSB)*

BIG IDEA: The King of kings has come!

READ: Matthew 21:1-11

THINK: Imagine being a witness to the events of Palm Sunday and then ask yourself these questions: *How would you arrange for a visiting President or other dignitary to come to town? To what town has Jesus come? Jesus comes on a donkey and not on a stallion. What does this portray? What kind of kingdom and king were the people expecting? How do their wishes compare with the reality of Jesus and His*
