BIG IDEA: Because of the first Christmas, God has not left us alone.

"I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Matthew 28:20b (CSB)



God...

- The Incarnation was prophetically announced.
- The Incarnation was miraculously accomplished.



God with...

- The Incarnation is an historic reality.
- The Incarnation is a present necessity.



God with us.

- The Incarnation elevates our humanity.
- The Incarnation equips our humanity.
- The Incarnation encourages our humanity.

BIG IDEA: Because of the first Christmas, God has not left us alone.

READ: Review some of the key passages from the message.

THINK: Meditate on the Incarnation of the Lord Jesus Christ, then ask yourself these questions: *What assurances and encouragement do you receive from the OT prophecies about the Incarnation? Why is it significant that all the Persons of the Trinity were involved in the Incarnation? What historical data is available to us that verifies Jesus as Emmanuel? In your own words, explain why Jesus' Incarnation is necessary. How does the reality that the Son of God became the Son of Man honor the human race? How does this reality enable us in our humanity?*

DO: What situation or circumstance are you facing right now where you need to rely on the reality that God is WITH you? Identify one person you can tell this Christmas about "God in the flesh", our precious Lord Jesus Christ!
