DO: Think of upcoming opportunities you might have in the days, weeks, and months ahead to be a witness for Jesus Christ. If you need help formulating a Gospel presentation, talk to one of the pastors or someone you may know who shares their faith regularly with others.

BIG IDEA: God’s purposes for the future will prevail.

*“Then I saw another angel rising up from the east,
who had the seal of the living God.”*

Revelation 7:2a (CSB)



God’s salvation has a redemptive purpose. (v1-3)

- **An angelic calm.** (v1)
- **An angelic caution.** (v2-3)



God saves Israel for His glory. (v4-8)

- **The 144,000: Who they are NOT.**
- **The 144,000: Who they ARE.** (v4-8)
- **The 144,000: What they will DO.** (v3; 14:1-5)

BIG IDEA: God’s purposes for the future will prevail.

READ: Revelation 7:1-8

THINK: Think about this distinctive group of 144,000 Jewish servants of God and then ask yourself the following questions: *Why is the description of the 144,000 Jews important in light of the prophecies we’ve studied so far? What have you learned about the Sovereignty of God in this passage? Does this bring you comfort? Why or why not? Since God is a “living God”, what does that mean to you*
