BIG IDEA: God uses angelic forces to accomplish His will.

*“And the seven angels
who had the seven trumpets
prepared to blow them.”*

Revelation 8:6 (CSB)

READ: Revelation 8:1-6

THINK: As you consider angelic involvement in future prophetic events, ask yourself the following questions: *When alone, do you like silence or do you need to have some noise going on? Amid seals and trumpets, why this silence? Are you ever moved to silence thinking about the things of God? Why the golden incense burner? What do altars and incense teach us about prayer (v 3-5; 5:8; 6:9-10; 9:13)? How do you feel knowing your prayers are always heard directly by God? Although you may not directly perceive their presence, how have angels potentially been active in your life? How does the readiness and punctuality of the angels motivate you in your service to God and the work of evangelism?*

DO: Determine how this passage will inform your prayers and why.



Angels in Waiting. (v1-2)

- **The Lamb opens the 7th Seal.** (v1a)
- **The sound of silence.** (v1b)
- **Seven angels take their place.** (v2a)
- **Seven trumpets for seven angels.** (v2b)



An Angel in Service. (v3-4)

- **Another angel takes his place.** (v3a)
- **Angelic administration of prayer.** (v3b-4)



Angels in Action. (v5-6)

- **An angel hurls warnings on the Earth.** (v5)
- **Seven angels prepare to execute God’s judgments.** (v6)
