BIG IDEA: God draws a line in the sand.

*“The seventh angel blew his trumpet...”
Revelation 11:15a (CSB)*



An announcement of victory. (v15)

- The beginning of the end.
- A bold chorus of voices.
- A recognition of supremacy.



An affirmation of praise. (v16-18)

- The posture of their praise.
- The person of their praise.
- The purpose of their praise.



An assurance of faithfulness. (v19)

- The certainty of God’s promise.
- The certainty of God’s purpose.
- The certainty of God’s presence.



Observations.

- **Authentic Christians live in reverent fear of God Almighty.**
- **Faith allows the Christ-follower to exist with the Kingdom tension of “already-but-not-yet”.**
- **The day is coming when God will “balance the books.”**
- **Our worship is not contingent upon circumstances but on the character, conduct, and competency of God Almighty.**

BIG IDEA: God draws a line in the sand.

READ: Revelation 11:15-19

THINK: As the 7th TRUMPET resounds, ask yourself the following questions: *What does the 7th TRUMPET Judgment herald? What is the “good news/bad news” scenario revealed in this passage today? How does this text (esp. v16-18) inform your worship here and now? What assurances do you find in these verses (esp. v19) that encourage and guide you for the living of these days?*

DO: How do you imagine God will reward you at the judgment? Why?
