BIG IDEA: Moms can make a big difference.
"The boy Samuel grew up in the presence of the Lord."
1 Samuel 2:21b (CSB)

Hannah's example of PRAYER. (1 Samuel 1:10-11)

- Her prayers were characterized by HONESTY.
- Her prayers were characterized by FAITH.

Hannah's example of SELF-DENIAL. (1 Samuel 1:27-28)

- She was not a "FOX-HOLE follower".
- She MEANT what she SAID.

Hannah's example of THANKFULNESS. (1 Samuel 2:1-10)

- Now tell us what you really think, Hannah!
- She developed an ATTITUDE of GRATITUDE.

Hannah's example of FAITHFULNESS. (1 Samuel 2:19-21)

- She was TRUE to her motherly duties.
- She was worthy of $\underline{\mathbf{5}}$ more children!


## How others perceived Hannah:

- Peninnah: An object of RIDICULE.
- Elkanah: An object of his AFFECTION.
- Eli: $1^{\text {st }}$ an object of PITY, then an object of ADMIRATION.
- Samuel: An object of LOVE and RESPECT.

BIG IDEA: Moms can make a big difference.

## READ: 1 Samuel 1 \& 2.

THINK: Think about the example of Hannah as a Mom, then ask yourself these questions: What has brought you the most joy in the past couple of years? The most grief? When you yearn for something and it doesn't happen, what do you do? Complain a lot? Get depressed? Pig out on junk food? Get mad at God? What are the most encouraging and discouraging things Hannah had going for her? What responses does her not having children evoke in Hannah? In Elkanah? In Peninnah? In Eli? How does this passage illustrate the evils of polygamy? What does Hannah intend for son by her vow? How do you think Hannah felt giving Samuel to someone else to raise? Considering Hannah's prayer of thanksgiving (2:1-10), what do you learn about the God she worships?
DO: What example does your life set for others? To which example in Hannah's life do you most relate: Her PRAYER, SELF-DENIAL, THANKFULNESS, or FAITHFULNESS? In which of those areas do you need to grow more?
