BIG IDEA: God fulfills all His promises to us in Jesus Christ.

The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed His glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14 (CSB)

BIG IDEA: God fulfills all His promises to us in Jesus Christ.

READ: John 1:1-14

THINK: As you reflect on this amazing passage from John 1, ask yourself these questions: What is your full name? How did your parents come up with it? What facts about "The Word" can you find in v1-5 & 10-18? As you think of Jesus as "The Word", what does it mean to receive & believe Him? What is the result of this type of faith? How would someone "full of grace and truth" treat others? How does the revelation of The Word in John 1 helps us know all of God's promises are fulfilled in Jesus Christ?

DO: Jesus made His dwelling among us. To what extent are you experiencing His presence in your life now? What strikes you most about Jesus in this passage. Why?
