BIG IDEA: History and prophecy reveal God's sovereignty over the Nations.

"Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain? The kings of the earth take their stand, and the rulers conspire together against the LORD and his Anointed One." Psalm 2:1, 2 (CSB)

Prophetic <u>HISTORY</u>, <u>ALREADY</u> fulfilled. (v2-35)

- The time of <u>AHASUERUS</u>. (v2)
- The time of <u>ALEXANDER</u>, <u>THE</u> <u>GREAT</u>. (v2-9)
- The time of <u>ANTIOCHUS</u>, <u>THE GREAT</u>. (v10-20)
- The time of <u>ANTIOCHUS</u>, <u>EPIPHANES</u>. (v21-35)
- Prophetic <u>HISTORY</u>, <u>YET TO BE</u> fulfilled. (v36-12:3)
 - The time of <u>ANTICHRIST</u>. (v36-12:1)
 - The time of <u>RESURRECTION</u> & <u>REWARD</u>. (v2 & 3)
- **LESSONS (So, what am I going to do about it?)**:

- <u>FUTURE</u> prophecies will be <u>FULFILLED</u> with the same <u>EXACTNESS</u> as those <u>PROPHECIES</u> already <u>FULFILLED</u>.
- o God <u>KNOWS</u> all <u>ABOUT</u> it.
- \circ <u>THINGS</u> are going to get <u>WORSE</u> before they get <u>BETTER</u>.
- Know <u>EXACTLY</u> where you <u>PLACE</u> your <u>TRUST</u>.

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Read: Daniel 11:2-12:3

Think: Consider the astonishing detail revealed in this extended prophetic passage, and then ask yourself the following questions: *What is your initial response to the exacting detail revealed in these prophecies? What lessons do you take from the "rise and fall of empires" described in this passage: pride going before the fall, abuse of power, lack of honor among thieves, futility of war, illusions of security, any other lessons? How are you struck by the phrase "at the appointed time" (v27, 29, 35)? In what does the Antichrist trust (v38-39)? What fierce battles does this evil figure wage (v40-45)? To what extent is he successful? How will he meet his demise? What is the "good news/bad news" dynamic of 12:1-3? Do: What does this passage teach you about the Christian's responsibility toward human government, good or bad? How do Christians and Churches and nations "honor a god of fortresses"? How do we rid ourselves of such a fortress-mentality? What is your hope in life and death?*
