## HOLY WEEK: PALM SUNDAY

*Luke 19:28-40*

**BIG IDEA:** The Lord Jesus Christ is coming as King!

*“Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord.*

*Peace in heaven and glory in the highest heaven!”*

*Luke 19:38 (CSB)*

### **A Voice of Submission: The Owners of the Colt. (v28-34)**

- Submission to King Jesus requires sacrifice.
- Submission to King Jesus requires service.

### **A Voice of Dedication: The Disciples. (v35-36)**

- Dedicated Disciples obey King Jesus.
- Dedicated Disciples celebrate King Jesus.

### **A Voice of Exhilaration: The Crowd . (v37-38)**

- Follow the crowd when they’re following King Jesus.
- Follow the crowd when they’re praising King Jesus.

### **A Voice of Objection: The Pharisees. (v39-40)**

- Objectors voice a self-righteous rebuke.

- Objectors receive a righteous response.

### **Lessons from Palm Sunday.**

- Who are the subjects of Christ’s Kingdom?
- Do I welcome King Jesus & His reign?
- What does the Lord require of me today?
- Do I offer King Jesus praise & worship when others will not?
- How do voices of praise on Sunday become reduced to silence or even derision on Friday?

**BIG IDEA:** The Lord Jesus Christ is coming as King!

**READ:** Luke 19:28-40

**THINK:** Reflect back on that first Palm Sunday, then ask yourself these questions:

*What was the big parade in your hometown? How have you ever participated in a parade? Where is Jesus right now in this text today? How close is He to Jerusalem? How did the owners of the donkey colt know who “the Lord” was? Why did they allow their colt to be used for this event? What task does Jesus give two of His Disciples? Why? What problems might they have encountered in such a task? How do you imagine the scene described in v35-38? What do you see? Hear? Feel? What do you suppose the people were expecting Jesus to do when He arrived in Jerusalem (compare v11 with Zechariah 9:9)? How are their expectations different than His? Why? What does Jesus’ reply to the Pharisees in v39-40 imply about Him?*

**DO:** What type of reception would Jesus receive if He rode into Caledonia/ Middleville? How can you live today with Jesus as King of your life?
