2 Corinthians 5:16-21

BIG IDEA: As His Ambassadors we represent God's message of peace to a hostile world.

"Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making His appeal through us. We plead on Christ's behalf, 'Be reconciled to God.'" 2 Corinthians 5:20 (CSB)

- An Ambassador must be a <u>CITIZEN</u> of the <u>NATION</u> he represents.
- An Ambassador must be COMMISSIONED.
- An Ambassador must represent his <u>RULER</u> and his <u>PEOPLE</u>.
- An Ambassador has all of his <u>NEEDS PROVIDED</u>.
- An Ambassador stays in <u>TOUCH</u> with <u>HEADQUARTERS</u>.

- An Ambassador must always be <u>PREPARED</u> to give ACCOUNT.
- An Ambassador is expected to <u>OBEY</u> the <u>LAWS</u> of the <u>LAND</u> and the <u>ORDERS</u> given to him.

BIG IDEA: As His Ambassadors we represent God's message of peace to a hostile world.

READ: 2 Corinthians 5:16-21

THINK: As you reflect on the idea of being an Ambassador for the King, ask yourself these questions: If you were appointed as an Ambassador for your country, where would you like to be sent? What does Paul mean by what he says about Christ and our response to Him (v15-17, see also Romans 6:5-13)? What does "reconciliation" mean? What does God do through Christ (v18)? Through us (v20)? For us (v17-18)? **DO**: How can you grow in your awe of God and love for Christ this week? What motivates you to share the Good News of Jesus Christ? What inhibits you?
