Revelation 2:4 (CSB)

- The Character. (v1b)
 - Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church.
 - o Jesus Christ is present among His Church.
- The Commendation. (v2-3)
 - o They were diligent.
 - They were intolerant.
 - They were <u>patient</u>.
- The Condemnation. (v4)
 - o No love for God.
 - No love for each other.
 - No love for the lost.

- The Command. (v5)
 - o Remember.
 - o Repent.
 - o Return.
- The Call. (v7a)
 - o A letter to one church.
 - o A message for all.
- The Challenge. (v7b)
 - o Be a faithful Overcomer.
 - Come back to the Source of Life.
 - Live with our eternal destiny in view.

BIG IDEA: What happens when love goes cold?

Read: Revelation 2:1-7
