**BIG IDEA:** Worship the King of Creation.

*"Our Lord and God,  
you are worthy to receive  
glory and honor and power."  
Revelation 4:11a (CSB)*



## The Center of Worship.

- He is LORD.
- He is GOD.
- He is CREATOR.



## The Voices of Worship.

- The 24 Elders.
- The 7-fold Spirit.
- The 4 Living Creatures.



## The Acts of Worship.

- Reverent posture.
- Verbal praise.
- Devoted offerings.



## The Words of Worship.

- We worship God for who He is.
- We worship God for what He does.
- We worship God for what He says.

**BIG IDEA:** Worship the King of Creation.

**READ:** Revelation 4:1-11

**THINK:** Try to imagine John's amazing experience before the throne of God and then ask yourself the following questions: *Where is John summoned when he hears the voice say, "Come up here"? Who is the figure on the throne? What is He like? What are the 24 Elders like? Who are they? What does the scene around the throne include? Note the many OT images referenced here (Genesis 9:12-17; Exodus 19:16-19, 25:31-40; 2 Chronicles 4:2-6; Ezra 1.) Who are the 4 Living Creatures and what are they like? What about the 4 Living Creatures suggests the eternal power of God? What response does the Central Figure of chapter 4 elicit from the 4 Living Creatures (v 7-8)? Why? What response does the Central Figure of Chapter 4 elicit from the 24 Elders? Why? What do these expressions of praise and worship say about who God is and how He relates to His creation?*

**DO:** How does this passage inform your personal and corporate worship here and now? If you had been in this scene, where would you have been? How can you give God the Father pure praise and worship this week?
