**BIG IDEA:** Worship the Lamb of Glory.

*“Worthy is the Lamb who was slaughtered  
to receive power and riches  
and wisdom and strength  
and honor and glory and blessing!”  
Revelation 5:12 (CSB)*



## The Center of Worship.

- He is the Lion of Judah.
- He is the Root of David.
- He is the Lamb.
- He is Co-regent with the Father.



## The Voices of Worship.

- The 1<sup>st</sup> Circle of Worship: Every created thing.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> Circle of Worship: The angelic host of heaven.
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> Circle of Worship: The 24 Elders.
- The 4<sup>th</sup> Circle of Worship: The 4 Living Creatures.



## The Acts of Worship.

- Reverent posture.

- Intercessory prayer.

- Verbal praise.



## The Words of Worship.

- They are a new song.
- They are a song of Redemption.
- They are a song of Victory.
- They are a song of praise.
  - The Worthy Lamb receives power.
  - The Worthy Lamb receives riches.
  - The Worthy Lamb receives wisdom.
  - The Worthy Lamb receives strength.
  - The Worthy Lamb receives honor.
  - The Worthy Lamb receives glory.
  - The Worthy Lamb receives blessing.
- They are the song of eternity.
- They are a solemn song.

**BIG IDEA:** Worship the Lamb of Glory.

**READ:** Revelation 4:1-11

**THINK:** Try to imagine John’s amazing experience before the throne of God and then ask yourself the following questions: *What is the best choral or musical group you*

*have heard (or participated in)? What was memorable about the experience? What do you think makes the scroll so significant? What dilemma does the sealed scroll pose? Why is Jesus Christ the only one worthy enough to open it (see v4, 9 & also John 1:29)? What titles are used to describe Him? What does it mean that He is both a Lion and a Lamb? Where does He appear? What is the significance of this? What is the response when He takes the scroll? Analyze the three songs: How is the Lamb described? Who comprises the first musical group? The second? The third? Who are the true kings and priests on earth? What elements of praise do you sense here?*

**DO:** What would the visions of Chapter 4 & 5 have meant to the persecuted Christians of Asia Minor (the 7 Churches of Chapters 2 & 3)? What does this vision say to guys in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century as we view our out-of-control world? Based on this, what actions will you take this week?
